REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ⇒ Learning agreement

- ⇒ Proof of language proficiency (if applicable)
- ⇒ Portfolio (only if you apply to the Nature and Landscape Architecture Department)



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

B1 level in French required.



HEALTH INSURANCE

Affiliation to the French social security scheme is compulsory for all International students (except European students).

European students will have to provide a copy of their European Health Insurance Card.
